1 General project Overview and Reference

Neom is a new area of 26,500 km² (10,200 sq mi) on the kingdom's Red Sea Coast.

The area includes multiple regions, including a floating industrial complex, global trade hub, tourist resorts and a linear city powered by renewable energy sources. It was launched in 2017 by Saudi crown prince Mohammed bin Salman.

In particular, Sindalah Island Project consists in a luxury island destination in the Red Sea, with a strong focus on conserving its surrounding natural beauty, most of which is untouched, with a sturdy rewilding programme.

Neom's much of the project is set to be built and open by 2030.

Project Schedule: SEA SRL carried out the pulling activities in August 2024.

Product Details: 2 Core Submarine MV Cables have been pulled: 36kV, XLPE insulated steel wire armored double layers type with integrated 32 cores Fiber optic pilot cable.
